The following restrictions apply:

No traveling on gravel roads: (1) ***During mud season as posted.*** (2) ***No traveling on gravel roads during school bus route hours from 6:30am thru 8:00am and 2:30pm thru 4:00pm. All Town Bridges are excluded from this permit.***

If more restricts are needed they will be attached separately.

This approval shall be effective for no more than one year period ending March 31, 20____.

The holder of a permit shall be liable for any damage to highways or bridges per VSA Title 23, Sec 1400a (c) and is required to furnish the municipality a valid Certificate of Insurance in the following amounts: A minimum of \$100,000/\$300,000 Personal Injury Liability Coverage and \$100,000 Property Damage Coverage.

The applicant will not travel on town roads until they receive an approved permit. The applicant is also responsible to inform his fleet of the above mentioned restrictions.

Note: Effective July 1, 1994, a Vermont State Permit is not required to operate on local highways and bridges

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANT

1. Permit is valid for up to one year or on March 31st.
2. Do not run on roads until permit is signed by a town official and is in your possession.
3. You must provide a copy of a valid certificate of insurance in the amount of a minimum of \$100,000/\$300,000 Personal Injury Liability Coverage and \$100,000 Property Damage Coverage.
4. Payment of \$5.00 for a single vehicle application, or \$10.00 for a fleet permit.
5. A copy of the permit issued will be carried in the vehicle or vehicles at all times.
6. Instruct all drivers on road restrictions stated in the permit. If restrictions are violated the Town has the right to pull your permit.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MUNICIPALITY

2. Effective July 1, 1994, a Vermont blanket permit is not required for issuance of Municipal Excess weight permit.
3. Special weight limits which are higher or lower than legal limits for highways or bridges within your jurisdiction must be on file with the Vermont Department of Motor Vehicles.
